Course Name	Course Description	Fees	Number your choices
Youth Wrestling	No experience required! For students in grades Kindergarten through 6th grade. Get in the wrestling room this summer and improve your skills or simply find out if this is a sport you like to do. Limit: 30 students/section.		
Physical Education: Sandlot Baseball	This course is designed to teach students the love for the game of baseball. Students enrolled in this class will play games like flip, pepper, hot box and more. While developing the love for game of baseball, we will also focus on developing skills such as base running, hitting, fielding, throwing. Each session will be capped at 30 students. Hurry space is limited!		
Explore the World	Take a trip around the World! We will learn about different parts of the world through literature, arts and crafts. Whoopsy-Wiffling World of Reading	If reading has you feeling muddled and jumbly, or even a tad frightsome, join us for a glimpse into the phiz-whizzing world of Roald Dahl! Meet some of his most froth-buggling characters as we enjoy independent reading, a read-aloud, movie, and activities. Limit: 25 students/section.		
Soccer	Sign up and learn about SOCCER in a fun and safe environment. In the class, you will learn eye/foot and eye/hand coordination, following directions, listening skills, motor skills, balance, and teamwork. There are two age groups, so students will be learning with students within their peer group. Students will work on individual skills such as dribbling, passing, receiving the ball, defensive moves, throw-ins, goalie and etc. Each class is broken up into 3 different segments: individual skills, small group games/activities, and a large group scrimmage/soccer related game. Limit: 30 students/section.		
Indoor and Outdoor Extravaganzas	Join “Indoor and Outdoor Extravaganzas” to have fun while learning many different things! Each week will be a different adventurous theme. Some examples will include yard game tournaments, cooperative games, and different themed arts and crafts, just to name a few.
