Course Name	Course Description	Fees	
Youth Wrestling	No experience required! For students in grades Kindergarten through 6th grade. Get in the wrestling room this summer and improve your skills or simply find out if this is a sport you like to do. Limit: 30 students/section.		
Knitting Basics	This class will teach students different styles and techniques for knitting. The first week is designated to finger knitting, second week to knitting with needles and the third week will be casting on and using the knit stitch. Students will take home at the end of the weeks: knitting needles, projects made and left over yarn. Limit: 15 students/section.	\$8.00	
Knitting Advanced and Advanced Plus	This class is offered to the students who have taken the Knitting Basic class or Advanced Knitting. We will be working on knitting in the round to knit a hat. For the Advance Plus class you will learn new stitches to help make more complex projects (possibly hat, scarf, mittens). Please bring with you your knitting bag, binder and needles from the Knitting Basics class. Students will take home at the end of the weeks: knitting needles, projects made and left over yarn. This course would have a maximum of 25 students.	\$8.00	
Beginning Scrapbooking	This class is designed for students grades 3-8 who want to learn what scrapbooking is all about. Students will learn how to use the tools available to create beautiful scrapbook pages that tell a story. Students must bring their own pictures, scrapbooks, and paper. \$10 course fee will provide some paper, some embellishments, and one tape runner per student, along with some card making and book making projects. Limit: 15 students/section.	\$10.00	
Advanced Scrapbooking	This course is designed for students who already have taken beginning scrapbooking and would like time to work on scrapbooking projects using the tools and supplies provided in the class. Students must bring their own pictures, scrapbooks, and paper. \$10 course fee will provide some paper, some embellishments, and one tape runner per student, along with some card making and book making projects. Building with Legos	Students will build vehicles, buildings, gears and whatever leaps into their imaginations! This class is a chance to offer students a time to relax, create, innovate and collaborate. Limit: 20 students/section.		
Physical Education: Sandlot Baseball	This course is designed to teach students the love for the game of baseball. Students enrolled in this class will play games like flip, pepper, hot box and more. While developing the love for game of baseball, we will also focus on developing skills such as base running, hitting, fielding, throwing. Limit: 30 students/section. Hurry space is limited!

Course Name	Course Description	Fees	Choice
Basketball	Calling all ball players to lace up your shoes and join us on the court! Do you have some experience playing ball? Have you thought about playing but haven't had the chance? Well, now is the time to brush up on your skills. We'll continue to build on the fundamentals of basketball and spend time enhancing those skills. Limit: 25 students/section.		
Archery	Participants will have the opportunity to explore the benefits of archery and build their skills under the supervision of a staff of archery professionals. Come achieve fantastic results all while having fun! Limit: 25 students/section.	\$3.00	
Fun Food and Friends	A class designed for fourth and fifth grade students to learn beginning kitchen and cooking skills. We learn to make healthy snacks and mixtures like playdough and gak while using the stovetop, oven and small appliances such as blenders and ice cream balls. You will learn inside and outside games all while having fun with friends! The cost for the course is \$10 per student with a limit of 20 students per class.	\$10.00	
Gizmos and Gadgets to Explore Physics and Chemistry	Students in this class will use the scientific method and the engineering design process to design and build devices to launch and throw objects in the spirit of Newton's Laws. They will also design and build bridges using different materials in a competition format to see which design will hold the most weight. Limit: 24 students/section.	\$10.00	
Whoopsy-Wiffling World of Reading	If reading has you feeling muddled and jumbly, or even a tad frightsome, join us for a glimpse into the phiz-whizzing world of Roald Dahl! Meet some of his most froth-buggling characters as we enjoy independent reading, a read-aloud, movie, and activities. Limit: 25 students/section.		
Football	If you like playing football, this is the class for you. In this class students will do some fundamental drills to help improve their skills. However, the majority of the class consists of playing flag football. Limit: 20 students.		
Soccer	Learn about SOCCER in a fun and safe environment. Learn eye/foot and eye/hand coordination, following directions, listening skills, motor skills, balance, and teamwork. Students will work on individual skills such as dribbling, passing, receiving the ball, defensive moves, throw-ins, goalie and etc. Each class is broken up into 3 different segments: individual skills, small group games/activities, and a large group scrimmage/soccer related game. Limit: 30 students/section.		
Game It Up	Are you competitive? Come and play a variety of indoor and outdoor games ranging from disc golf, capture the flag, and checkers. In "Game It Up" we will have a maximum of 30 students/section. Wear athletic gear and be prepared to go outside.		
Indoor and Outdoor Extravaganzas	Have fun while learning many different things! Each week will be a different adventurous theme.
