COURSES FOR STUDENTS FINISHING SIXTH-EIGHTH GRADE			
Course Name	Course Description	Fees	Choice
Summer Intro to Golf	Students will learn the basics of golf including, set-up / stance, swing mechanics, putting, equipment, etiquette, and scoring. Students do not need their own equipment, but they may bring clubs if they have them. After two weeks of "range" practice, we will take a field trip to Clifton Highlands (par 3 course) for a round of 9 holes. Limit: 15 students/section.	\$15.00	
Basketball	This class will only be offered from 8:00-9:20am at the High School. Learn and practice the fundamentals of basketball. In this class, students will practice basic skills of the game of basketball. Students will also play many different basketball related games, as well as scrimmage against other classmates. Limit: 20 students.		
Archery	Participants will have the opportunity to explore the benefits of archery and build their skills under the supervision of a staff of archery professionals. Come achieve fantastic results all while having fun! Limit: 25 students/section	\$3.00	
Physical Education: Advanced Baseball Hitting	This course is designed to teach advanced hitting and base running skills needed to prepare players to compete at a higher level. Students will take a bus to Bob Young Field to utilize the various hitting equipment - including batting cages, curve ball machine, fastball/change-up machine, video analysis and our ZEPP hitting tool - daily at Bob Young Field (weather permitting). This program will teach each athlete what they need to know to be successful on the baseball field in the batter's box. Limit: 20 athletes.		
Youth Wrestling	No experience required! For students in Kindergarten-6th grade . Get in the wrestling room this summer and improve your skills or simply find out if this is a sport you like to do. Limit: 30 students/section.		
MS/HS Wrestling	Grades 7-12. We will work technique and live wrestle. Limit: 50 students.		
Weight Training	Students and student athletes in grades 7th-12th grade will learn proper weight lifting techniques, aerobic and anaerobic exercises, and muscle confusion and program differentiation. The weight room will also be available for any athletes who would like to come in during the day and work out between 6am-12pm.		
Football	If you like playing football, this is the class for you. In this class students will do some fundamental drills to help improve their skills. However, the majority of the class consists of playing flag football. Limit: 20 students.		
Soccer	This class is available only to students who have just completed 6th grade. Learn about SOCCER in a fun and safe environment. In the class, you will learn eye/foot and eye/hand coordination, following directions, listening skills, motor skills, balance, and teamwork. There are two age groups, so students will be learning within their peer group. Students will work on individual skills such as dribbling, passing, receiving the ball, defensive moves, throw-ins, goalie and etc. Each class is broken up into 3 different segments: individual skills, small group games/activities, and a large group scrimmage/soccer related game. Limit: 30 students.		
Outdoor Games and Activities	We will play a variety of different outdoor games such as, ultimate frisbee, sharks and whales, kickball, and much more! Limit: 30 students/section.

Course Name	Course Description		Fees	Choice
Game It Up	Are you competitive? Come and play a variety of indoor and outdoor games ranging from disc golf, capture the flag, and checkers. In "Game It Up" we will have a maximum of 30 students/section . There will be two sessions for grades 3-5 and one section for grades 6-8. Wear athletic gear and be prepared to go outside.			
Babysitting Basics	Be certified to be a babysitter through the Red Cross. In this course you will learn water safety, basic aid training, first aid for children, family caregiving, first aid and preparedness, as well as safely setting up a babysitting business. The course cost is \$25 which includes training materials and Red Cross certification. Limit of 12 students/section.		\$25.00	
Gizmos and Gadgets to Explore Physics and Chemistry	Students in this class will use the scientific method and the engineering design process to design and build devices to launch and throw objects in the spirit of Newton's Laws. They will also design and build bridges using different materials in a competition format to see which design will hold the most weight. \$10 class fee. Limit: 24 students/section. Grade Levels 4-8.		\$10.00	
Knitting Advanced and Advanced Plus	This class is offered to the students who have taken the Knitting Basic class or Advanced Knitting. We will be working on knitting in the round to knit a hat. For the Advance Plus class you will learn new stitches to help make more complex projects (possibly hat, scarf, mittens). Please bring with you your knitting bag, binder and needles from the Knitting Basics class. This class would have an \$8 fee for materials. Students will take home at the end of the weeks: knitting needles, projects made and left over yarn. Limit: 25 students.		\$8.00	
Beginning Scrapbooking	This class is designed for students grades 3-8 who want to learn what scrapbooking is all about. Students will learn how to use the tools available to create beautiful scrapbook pages that tell a story. Students must bring their own pictures, scrapbooks, and paper. \$10 course fee will provide some paper, some embellishments, and one tape runner per student, along with some card making and book making projects. Limit: 15 students/section.		\$10.00	
Advanced Scrapbooking	This course is designed for students who already have taken beginning scrapbooking and would like time to work on scrapbooking projects using the tools and supplies provided in the class. Students must bring their own pictures, scrapbooks, and paper. \$10 course fee will provide some paper, some embellishments, and one tape runner per student, along with some card making and book making projects. Limit: 15 students/section.		\$10.00	
Clay and Sculpture	This art class will focus on the use of clay to create sculptures and basic clay forms. Several construction techniques will be used such as pinch, slab, coil and drape forms. The students will also glaze their art forms. Other sculpture mediums and techniques will be explored as time allows. Limit: 18 students.		\$5.00	
Making the Mural	The students will be participating in the creation of making a clay mosaic mural. The mural will be for the outside wall of the Ellsworth Klaas-Jonas pool. The students will be designing, making, and glazing clay tiles. They will learn the drying and firing process of clay. The students will also have the opportunity to create a relief tile of their own design to take with them. Limit: 18 students.		\$5.00	
ARTJournaling 101	Your Daily dose of Design, Drawing and Doodling. The students will be working on the visual journaling process in their own sketchbook, which will be provided. Each day the students will explore new ideas for their journal. Ideas such as drawing, painting, collage, mapping of ideas, illustrating, and writing will be explored using a variety of techniques and mediums. Limit: 18 students.		\$10.00	
Upcycled Crafts	Join us in creating fun projects from items found around the house! Using those items in new ways, along with a few simple supplies, we'll turn trash into treasure with useful and decorative crafts, such as t-shirt bags, locker pockets, bookmarks and more!
