Football	Would you like to learn more about the game of football? Blocking and tackling techniques, agility, and proper footwork are some of the skills to be taught and practiced. In this physical education class, players will learn about different positions on a football team.		
Wrestling	This course will focus on basic technique of wrestling in both the neutral and referee's position. Wrestlers will also learn how to improve their speed and agility. The older wrestlers will be educated on proper weight training and dieting. The course is divided into three sections according to grade level- Grades 3-4, 5-6, and 7.		
Basketball	Do you like to shoot baskets, and play sports with your friends? Do you want to increase your basketball skills? This physical education summer school class will emphasize basketball skills and drills, and will include time for games with classmates.		
Music Around the World	Go on a journey around the world while singing, playing, and moving to the music of select countries. We will be using pitched and un pitched percussion.		
Dancing in Style	Do you like to move to music? This PE dance class will help you learn new steps and new dances, and work on your own dance style as you move to hip hop, jazz, and more.		
Two Heads are Better than One	In this class, you will learn how to work as a team, to work through challenges, to play games together, and to make friends. Team building teaches us important skills like being good listeners, how to work together, how to problem solve, and how to be a positive leader.		
Soccer	Interested in developing soccer skills? This class for beginners will focus on learning about soccer, practicing skills used in soccer, and developing skills to play soccer. Related fitness activities will be included as part of each class.		

Ongoing summer school classes will be available at Hillcrest/Prairie View Elementary Schools throughout July and August from 9:30-11:00 each morning and 1:00-2:30 each afternoon. The morning class will focus on Summer Success Reading, while integrating various weekly themes throughout the summer.
