Credit Check

- Very closely look at your credit checker to ensure you are fulfilling all your graduation requirements
 - How many English, Social Studies, Science, Math, Relationships, Computer, Elective classes do you need?
- You **MUST** register for failed required classes that you did not make up already (taken the class again ... and passed)
 - English, Math, Social Studies, Science, Comp 1

4 Year College Bound Students

3 years of Math (some require 4 years of math)
3.5 years of Social Studies
4 years of English
3 years of Science, inc. a lab (Chem/Anat)
2 years Foreign Language

2 Year College Bound Students

Same requirements to graduate from high school, except some health programs require up through Chemistry and/or Anatomy.

Music Students

- Must register for entire year of music.
 - This will take up 4 lines.
 - If in band and choir - only use 4 lines; not 8
- Single music students
 - Intro to Theatre, Art 1, Comp 1
 - Write the study hall or skinny class on a music line (since it combines to make one full block)
 - So, total the single music and study hall will only take up 4 lines

New Opportunities

AP US History (APUSH)

- Benefit? College credit if pass AP final and 0.05 bonus weighted GPA added per quarter
- Use three lines = three quarters = cross off "Hist 10" as one line and add two more (ask Counselor to take Hist 10 out of registration in IC).
- These three classes will take care of US Hist 10 requirement; not Western Civilization requirement
- Will still need Western Civilization
- 4 quarters of social studies total

Advanced Standing Classes:

Transcribed Credit - Direct credit from CVTC. Upon successful completion, grades are posted to an official transcript from the college and tabulated into your college GPA. Generally transferable to other colleges.

Advanced Standing - Credit is delayed until you apply to CVTC or another technical school in WI. You can earn the credit, but the grade does not apply to your college GPA. Must earn a B or better.

Study Hall

Only single music students who do not want skinnies both semesters should have study halls.

Signatures

- Parent
 - Review entire schedule and sign
- Teacher
 - Signatures are required for math

Classes that Run Longer Than 1 Quarter

If a class runs longer than 1 quarter, it will have 1 number with A - D after each term

- Math, Spanish, Science, AP, PLTW, Eng
 - Alg 2A, Alg 2B
 - Span. 2A, Span. 2B
- These classes need 2 lines
- Choir/Band needs 4 lines

Career Plans of Study

*The five credits of Math required for graduation must be fulfilled by completing algebra I as Algebra I CORE, Geometry as Geometry CORE, and Algebra II, Algebra II CORE, or Math for the Trades.

**The completion of a health class is required by graduation from EHS. Most students completed this requirement with Health II. If you did not complete Health II that time you must take a health class within high school.

ENGLISH: *Normal sign up for English 10 (1104 & 1105)

SCIENCE: *Normal sign up for Biology 10 (1004 & 1005)

SOCIAL STUDIES: *Normal sign up for U.S. History 10 (1005 and Western Civilization 1002)

MATH: *Normal take a year of math - see your instructor for placement. *Must four year college degree students to complete Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra I as minimum high preparation. *Technical college recommend Algebra I as a minimum.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION: *Normal sign up for Phy Ed 10 (1015)

FOREIGN LANGUAGE: *Must four year colleges including UNH, Oberlin, UNH Star Class, and Elworths colleges have a one credit foreign language requirement for admission. *This year responsibility to check what other colleges require for foreign language.

RELATIONSHIPS: *Deliver grades 10-12. 3 credit of Relationship is required.

Plan to make up any required courses you may have failed
