**\*The three credits of Math required for graduation must be fulfilled by completing Algebra I or Algebra I CORE, Geometry or Geometry CORE, and Algebra II, Algebra II CORE, or Math for the Trades.**

- The completion of a Health class is required to graduate from EHS. Most students complete this requirement with Health 8. If you did not complete Health at that time, you must take a Health class while in high school (10th, 11th, or 12th grade).

- Freshmen are limited to one level of a subject area per year (foreign language/math). \*\*Unless given special permission by the instructor.
