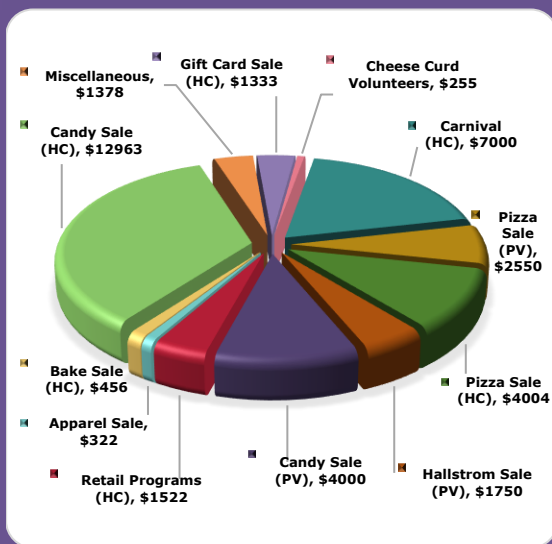
Welcome to the *final year* at Hillcrest, Lindgren and Prairie View Elementary and the *first year* at Ellsworth Elementary School!
