## Expectations of the Classroom

Every child in the Early Childhood program works on their individualized IEP goals, as well as overarching classroom goals and expectations. Some of these include:

- Self-help skills: putting on and taking off winter wear, using eating utensils, drinking from a cup, pouring liquid into a cup, washing hands, daily routines, potty training.
- Cutting skills
- Other fine motor development and skills (holding writing utensil correctly)
- Social skill development (learning how to play with peers and toys appropriately/learning how to self-regulate emotions)
- Sorting and matching objects
- Identifying own name, colors, and shapes
- Taking responsibility of classroom materials and one's own possessions (putting backpack in cubby, and cleaning up at the end of playtime)
- In collaboration with other service providers all students will work on speech, gross and fine motor skills.

## Progress Reports

The family will be notified quarterly by the child's case manager that will show the growth of the child's IEP goals. In the event that the child does not make growth the team will review the goal(s) and discuss the next steps.

## Supplies/Snack

Once your child has qualified for services a snack and supply list will be provided by the Early Childhood Teacher. If your child wears diapers or pull-ups, please supply these items. If you do not wish to purchase the other supply/snack items, you do have the option of purchasing a \$25 gift card from Walmart or Target and supplies for your child will be purchased by the Early Childhood staff.

## Busing Information

Busing is provided by the school district at no cost to the family. We have two Early Childhood buses. Each bus has five-point harness car seats. Our drivers are skilled and have been with the district for a number of years. A parent, or caretaker puts the child on the bus, and our staff will take the child off the bus when they arrive at school (this concept is the in reverse order when the child is brought home). If anything changes with your child's transportation needs, please contact the bus garage, and Ms. Jackie.
