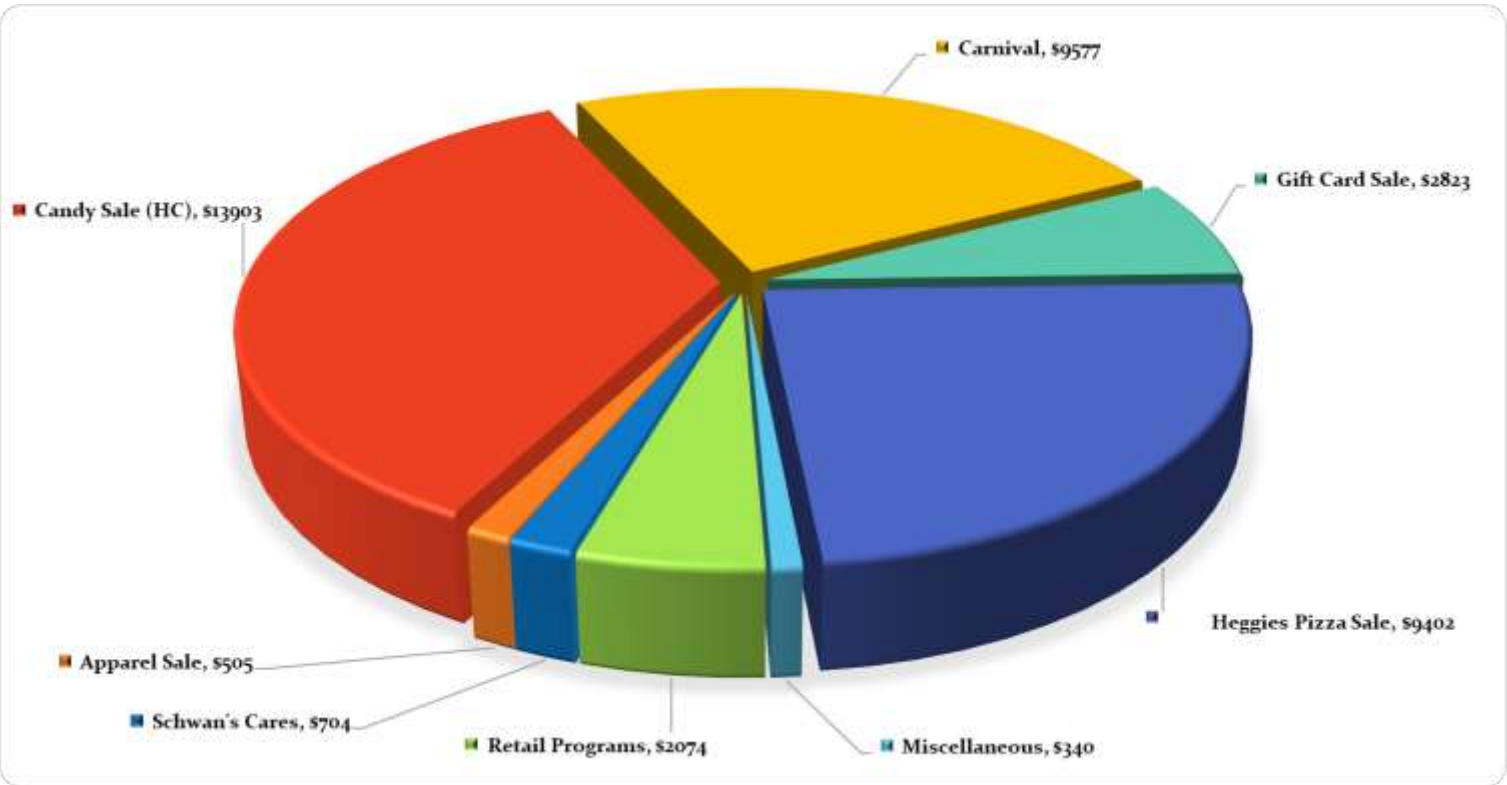

Thank you to all who attended the Family Game and Bingo Night on April 27th. We hope you had a fun time. A special thank you to Kim Meier for chairing this event.

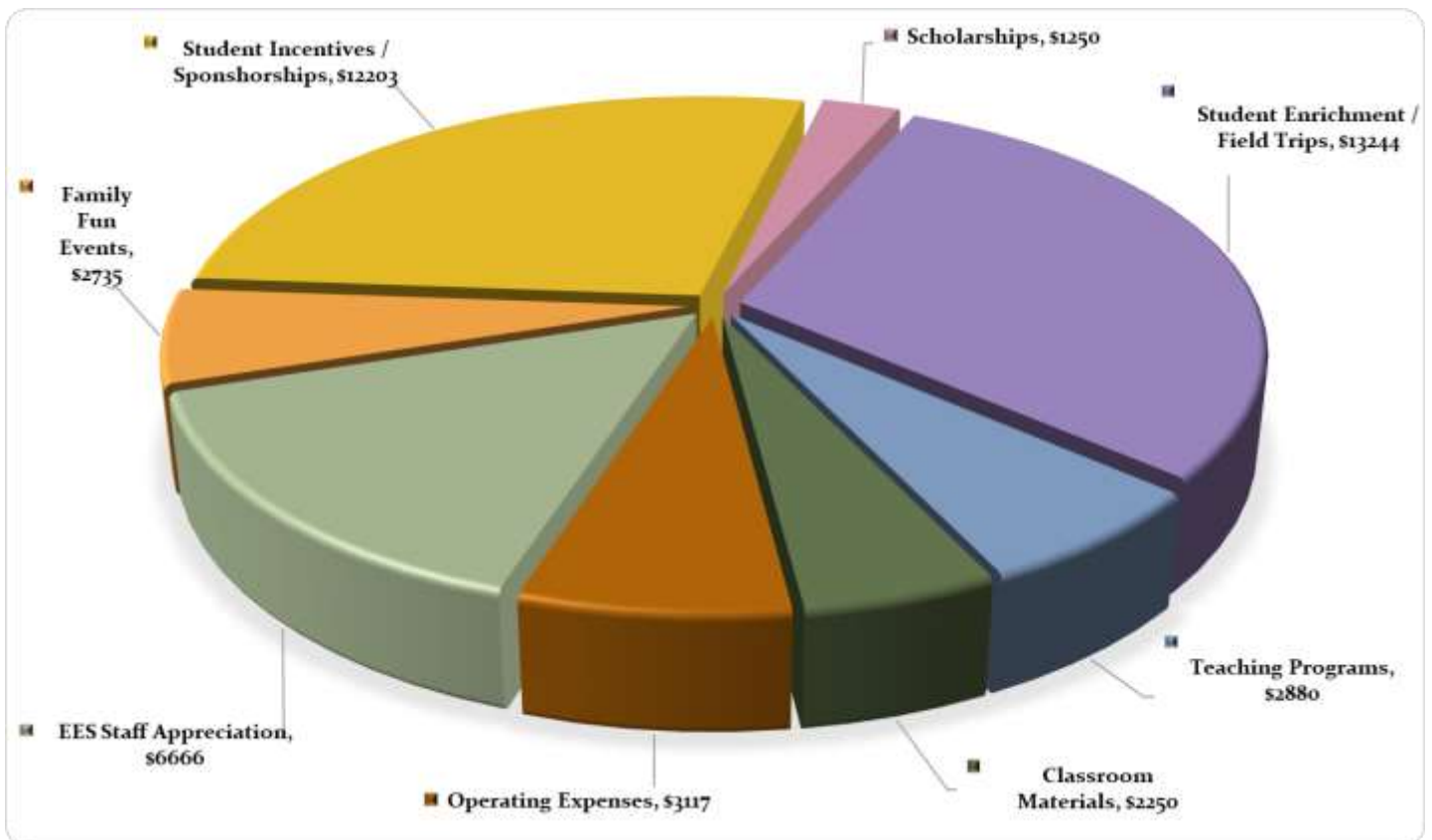
