

PANTHER KIDS' CLUB BEHAVIOR POLICY

Panther Kids' Club (PKC) is a before/after school daycare program. It is hosted at the elementary school sites of Prairie View and Hillcrest Elementary Schools. Like any childcare / daycare program, PKC has a child behavior policy in place. We hope that the program provides value, convenience and quality care for your child. Behavior Expectations

To ensure a fun and safe learning environment, the Panther Kids' Club requires that the participants will:

1. Respect the PKC staff and volunteers.
2. Respect PKC rules (& school rules).
3. Respect PKC materials and equipment.
4. Take responsibility for their actions.

PKC staff reviews behavior expectations on a weekly basis.

Behavior Consequences

*PKC has a three strike policy. If your child is not following expectations, he/she may earn a strike.

- 1st - parent is provided a written statement with detail as to what incident occurred.
- 2nd - parent is provided a written statement with details. In addition, a three day suspension from PKC will be scheduled.
- 3rd - child will be removed from PKC for the remainder of the school year.

*If it is determined by the PKC staff that the severity of the child's behavior is a detriment to the environment or the safety of others, parents will be required to withdraw the child from the program immediately.
