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## Community

Ellsworth is located in the center of Pierce County, Wisconsin, and is the county seat. Primarily a rural area, Ellsworth is geographically considered part of the Twin Cities metropolitan area and presently has a population of about 3,300 people.

## School

Ellsworth High School serves approximately 500 students in grades 9-12 and offers a wide variety of courses for the college bound and vocational oriented student. The 1:15 teacher/student ratio allows students the opportunity for personal teacher attention.

## Block Schedule

EHS utilizes a Block Schedule format. This format appears as four class periods a day that are approximately 90 minutes each. All students have a 30 minute homeroom period.
