

Scholarship Information

Other scholarship programs include – Contact the EHS Guidance office for specific contact information:

- **Academic Excellence Scholarship:** This scholarship is awarded to high school seniors who have the highest grade point average in their graduating class. The number at each high school is determined by the high school enrollment. The value of the scholarship is \$2,250 per year to be applied towards tuition.
- **Hearing & Visually Impaired Student Grant:** Students who show financial need and have a severe or profound hearing or visual impairment may qualify. The award is up to \$1,800 per year for up to 10 semesters.
- **Indian Student Assistance Program:** Wisconsin residents who are at least 25% Native American and enrolled in a Wisconsin higher education institution are eligible. Award amounts vary.
- **Talent Incentive Grant (TIP):** The TIP grant provides assistance to the most financially needy and educationally disadvantaged Wisconsin students attending college. First time freshmen students are nominated for the TIP Grant by the school financial aid office or high school counselors.
- **Teacher of the Visually Impaired Loan:** The Teacher of the Visually Impaired Loan Program provides loans to Wisconsin residents who are enrolled at least half-time in a program that prepares them to be licensed teachers of the visually impaired.
- **Contract For Dental Education – Marquette University:** This program allows a small number of students to attend the Marquette

University School of Dentistry and receive tuition subsidization of \$8,753.

- **Teacher Education Loan – Milwaukee Public Schools:** The Teacher Education Loan program provides loan forgiveness to Wisconsin residents who agree to teach in the Milwaukee Public School district. For each year taught in the school district, 50% of the loan is forgiven.
- **Nursing Loan Forgiveness Program:** Available to Wisconsin residents enrolled in nursing. Recipients agree to work as a nurse in Wisconsin. Total maximum award is \$15,000 (\$250-\$3,000 per year).
- **Academic Competitiveness Grant (ACG):** For students who will be freshmen in 2015-16, enrolled full-time in a 2 or 4 year program, pell eligible, and complete a rigorous high school schedule. First year grant is \$750 and second year grant is \$1300. For more information, go to:

- **National Science and Mathematics Access to Retain Talent (SMART) Grant:** Up to \$4000 in 3rd and 4th years of undergraduate study. Must be a full time student, pell eligible with a 3.0 cumulative GPA, and enrolled in any of the following programs: Computer Science, Engineering, Critical Foreign Languages, Life Sciences, Mathematics, Physical Sciences, Technology, or Multidisciplinary Studies.
