

YOUTH OPTIONS PROGRAM
2018 – 2019 School Year

The Youth Options Program allows all public high school juniors and seniors who meet certain requirements to take post-secondary courses at a UW institution, a Wisconsin technical college, or one of the state's participating private nonprofit institutions of higher learning.

Students do not have to pay for a post-secondary course if the school board determines the course may receive high school credit and the course is not comparable to a course offered in the school district. **The Ellsworth School District will pay for a maximum of 18 college credits through the Youth Options program during a student's junior and senior years in high school.** Students who take more than the 18 credit maximum are responsible for the costs.

This form must be completed and turned in to determine the numbers of students who would be interested in taking a Youth Options course during the school year. This form **does not** automatically sign you up for a course, it only gives the school district an idea of how many students have an interest in pursuing a course at the post-secondary level. Once the Fall/Spring schedules from Wisconsin post-secondary institutions come out students will at that time complete an application for the program.
